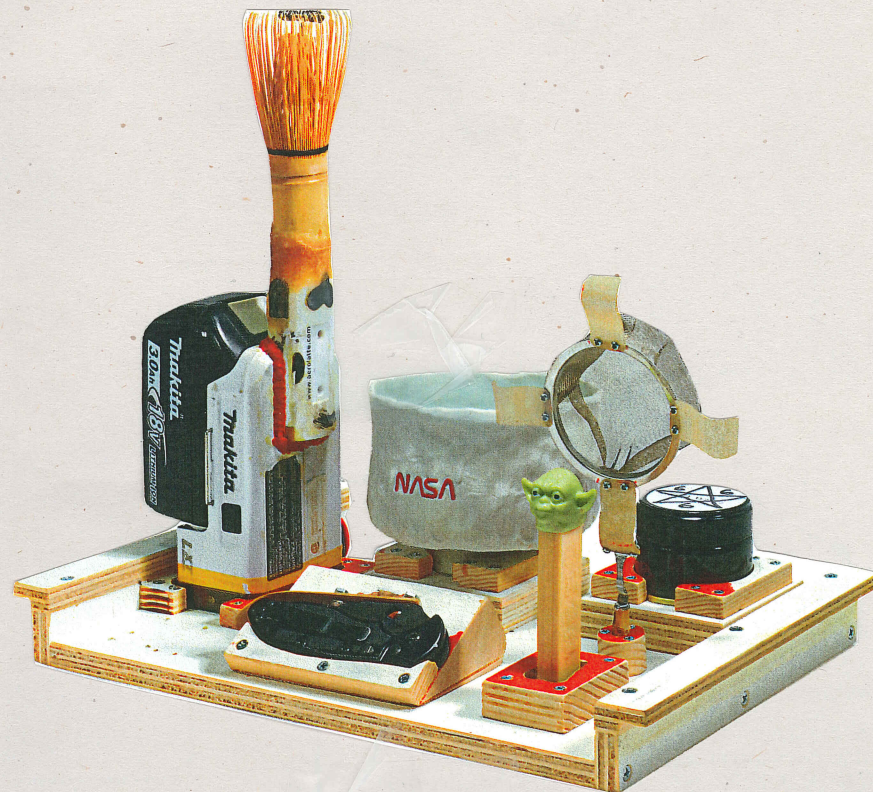

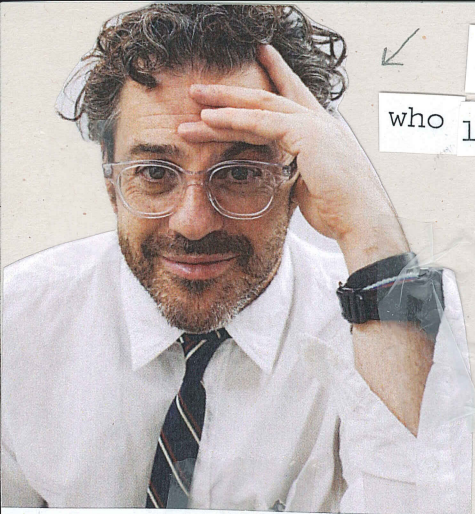

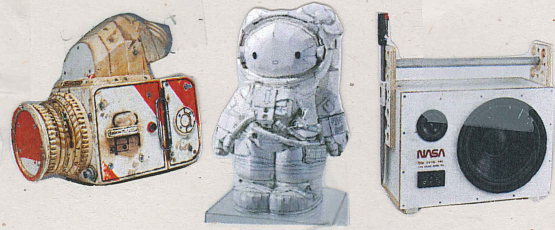

 Ceremonies bring people together.



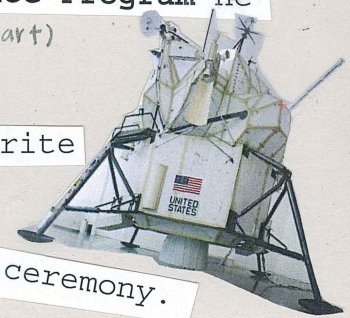

 that uses everyday materials.

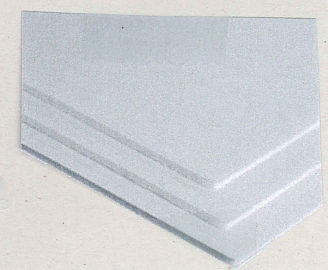
