Genzken is always in the studio working and for her, everything has the potential to become sculptural material: office furniture, toy soldiers, ribbons, jewelry, fabric, rain boots, flowers, and more.

## FROM GENZKEN

*The intention is to get a different reaction from the "already known."  
I can't explain it any other way.*

*It's much better when one interrupts this routine in order to approach what one does differently.*

*...I had an idea and I realized it forcefully. Then I stopped doing that suddenly, and a new phase started: Just go ahead. And the rigor of all those years is still in me.*

*It's important not to be all tensed up in the visual work one is doing.  
One has to maintain one's sense of humor  
and wit.*
