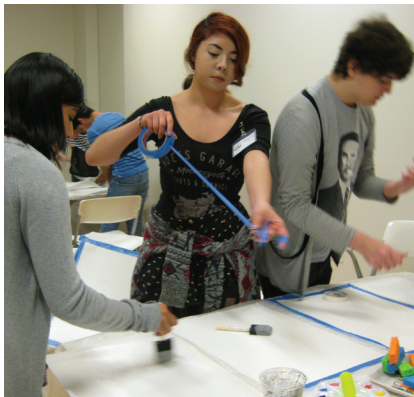




# Nasher Summer Institute for Teens

Teachers of grades 9-12 are invited to nominate students for the seventh annual Nasher Summer Institute for Teens.

## Who can be nominated

Students who have completed grade 9, 10, 11 or 12 in 2014 may be nominated for the Institute.

## An ideal candidate:

- Shows strong interest in pursuing a college degree or career in art history or studio art.
- Is an active participant in your classes who often goes beyond basic requirements.
- Has independent interests and incorporates his/her unique vision into projects.
- Has a positive attitude and works well with other students.

## What participants can expect

The Nasher Summer Institute for Teens is a week-long program that exposes students to many aspects of museums and the art world.

## The 2014 Institute will include:

- In-depth learning experiences with artworks in the Nasher Collection.
- Sessions with a variety of art-world professionals, including educators, gallerists, conservators and designers.
- Hands-on projects focused on artistic process with practicing, professional artists.
- Visits to selected museums and galleries.

## Program details

- The Nasher Summer Institute for Teens will be held Monday, Monday, June 23 through Friday, June 27, 2014 from 10am – 4pm.  
**Application deadline is April 25, 2014.**
- Up to 30 students will be accepted. Finalists will be selected by Nasher staff and will be notified of their acceptance by May 2, 2014.
- Tuition for accepted participants is free of charge, and includes art supplies, meals, and a transportation stipend.
