Keep these things in mind when designing your bookmark:

- All designs must fit within a 3-inch by 9-inch rectangle.
- Designs should be inspired by the Nasher Sculpture Center.
- You may use crayons, markers, pencils, paint, or other materials that will lay flat.
- For a successful design, fill in the space all the way to the edges of the rectangle.
- Lay your paper flat when you submit your design. Don't fold it!


Regular Hours and Admission:

Make Your Mark Contest Rules

1. By entering, participants certify that their submission is the original work of the student named above and not a copy of an existing original.
2. Parent/legal guardian of winner gives permission to the Dallas Public Library and Nasher Sculpture Center to use any photo taken of participant for internal publications and outside publications, such as national library publications and local newspapers.
3. ELIGIBLE participants must be in or entering grades 2-12 and live in the city of Dallas or attend a Dallas school, charter school or a home school within these geographical limits.
4. Entries may be mailed or may be returned to the Admissions Desk of the Nasher Sculpture Center. All entries must be received by August 2, 2015. No entries will be returned.
5. Designs must fit within a 3" x 9" rectangle. Designs may be submitted on this form or another sheet of paper.
6. All submissions will be judged on the originality and quality of the design. All qualified entries will be selected from one of the following grade categories, 2-4, 5-7, 8-12, and judged separately. All decisions of the judging committee are final.
7. Parents/legal guardians of all participants give the Dallas Public Library and Nasher Sculpture Center permission to print, publish, use, or offer for sale any winning entry by a finalist or grand prize winner. Entries may be used for any and all purposes including, but not limited to, advertising, publicity, publication, and exhibition in any media known or hereafter devised. All rights to entries will be retained by the author with the Dallas Public Library and Nasher Sculpture Center being granted permission to use the entry at its discretion.
