

How do you... ... cast a sculpture?

A cast is a three-dimensional copy of an original sculpture made from a mold. Here is a simplified explanation of how a cast is made:


First, an artist makes an original sculpture.




Next, plaster, rubber or another material is applied to all sides of the sculpture, making a mold.



The mold is cut open and the original sculpture is removed. Then, the mold is put back together.



Plaster or melted metal is poured into the mold and left to harden.



Finally, the mold is taken away creating a copy of the original in a new material.


