Lunches and Supplies Included

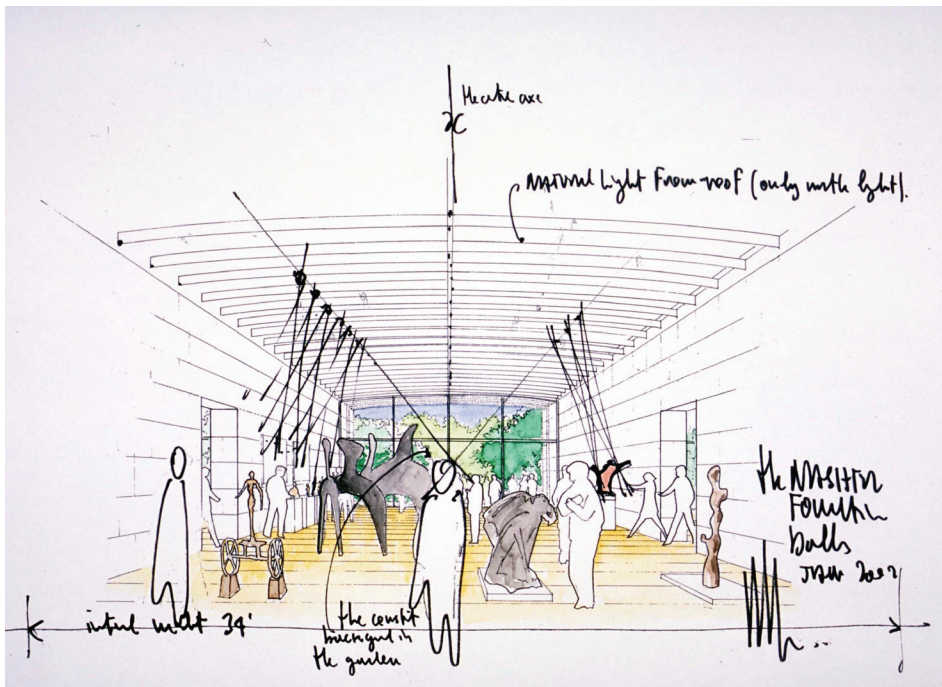

Destination DFW participants will:

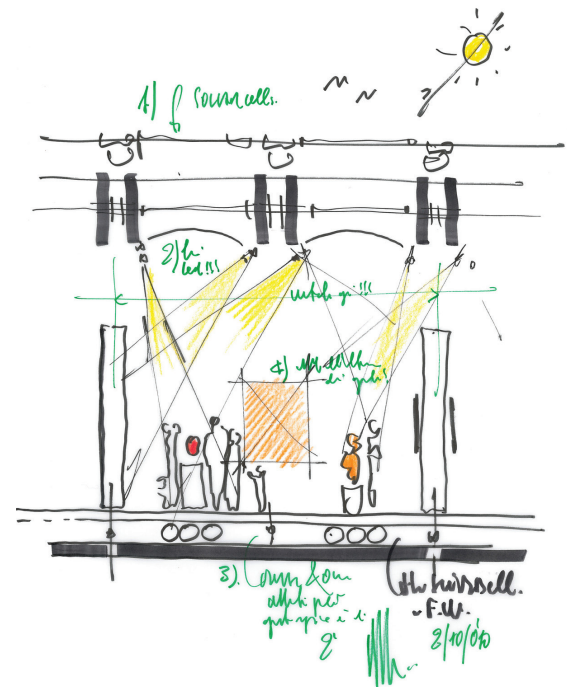
- develop and explore drawing and visual thinking skills
