- Nasher Sculpture Center requires a certified and licensed event planner, or agreed upon alternative, for all events.
- Nasher Sculpture Center is not responsible for any items brought onto the premises by Client.
- Smoking is not permitted anywhere on Nasher Sculpture Center property.
- Animals are not allowed in the Nasher Sculpture Center, with the exception of service animals.
- Nasher Sculpture Center does not allow any open flames, candles, or sparklers.
- Nothing may be affixed to the walls, indoors or outdoors.
- Wolfgang Puck Catering is Nasher Sculpture Center’s exclusive caterer. Neither Client, nor Client’s guests may bring any food or beverage into Nasher Sculpture Center.
- Parking arrangements to be made independently by client.
- Nasher Sculpture Center will provide all security. No outside officers can be contracted by Client except with the approval of the Center.
- Outside vendors will enter the building at the designated entrances only. Event setup may start no earlier than 3 p.m. on the day of the event. Nothing may be left at the Center overnight unless previously discussed and approved by Nasher Sculpture Center staff.
- Amplified music must end at 11 p.m. in the garden on Fridays and Saturdays, 10 p.m. Sunday–Thursday. Nasher Sculpture Center reserves the right to lower volume of entertainment at any time.
